PARKING INFORMATION & DRIVING DIRECTIONS for OFF-CAMPUS participants

Parking information in this box is ONLY for participants staying in HOTELS or other <u>OFF-CAMPUS</u> accommodation. (Those staying on-campus should see the separate housing confirmation email.)

- DRIVING DIRECTIONS & WHERE TO PARK: UCSB is easily accessible from highway US-101. Note that if using driving directions/maps websites (such as Mapquest), there is no proper street address for UCSB; you can get basic directions by entering just the zip code of "93106".
 - <u>CHES TUESDAY Registration & Rump Session (August 16) & PROOFS (August 20)</u>: Parking available in the Lot 3 Parking Structure after 5:00pm and on Saturday. You will need to buy a "pay and display" permit (\$4 evening/weekend rate) from the machine at the front of the lot.

From the South: Take US-101 northbound to the Airport/UCSB/Hwy 217 exit (appx. 8 mi. north of downtown Santa Barbara). This expressway will take you directly into campus. As you enter campus, stay in the left lane; enter the roundabout and move into the right lane to exit onto Lagoon Road. Turn right at the first stop sign onto UCEN Road and follow the road to the end, turning RIGHT into LOT 3 PARKING before you come to the stop sign.

From the North: Take US-101 to the Storke/Glen Annie Rd. exit. Turn right on Storke Road and proceed 2 miles to El Colegio Road. Turn left on El Colegio Road and proceed through the campus West Gate. Turn left at the second traffic light (Ocean Rd.) after entering campus and follow the signs to Anacapa or Santa Rosa Hall. When you enter the Roundabout, please get into the right lane and immediately get off on Lagoon Road. Turn right at the first stop sign onto UCEN Road and follow the road to the end, turning RIGHT into LOT 3 PARKING before you come to the stop sign.

 CHES Tutorial & FDTC (Tuesday, August 16) & CHES (Wednesday – Friday, August 17-19): Parking in Mesa Parking Structure. You will need to buy a "pay and display" permit (\$8 for the day) from the machine at the front of the lot. Please note that you should follow the signs from the Mesa Parking Structure to the University Center Corwin Pavilion for FDTC and the CHES Registration Wednesday – Friday. CHES Sessions are being held in Campbell Hall. Note that this permit is good after 5:00pm closer to the Anacapa Residence Hall.

From the South: Take US-101 northbound to the Airport/UCSB/Hwy 217 exit (appx. 8 mi. north of downtown Santa Barbara). This expressway will take you directly into campus. As you enter campus, stay in the right lane and proceed on Mesa Road (do not enter the roundabout). Turn left at the second traffic light into University Plaza, then make the first right and proceed into the MESA/18 PARKING STRUCTURE. CHES registration will be held in the University Center Corwin Pavilion Wednesday – Friday. CHES sessions take place in Campbell Hall.

From the North: Take US-101 to the Storke/Glen Annie Rd. exit. Turn right on Storke Road and proceed 2 miles to El Colegio Road. Turn left on El Colegio Road and proceed through the campus West Gate. After entering campus, turn left at the second traffic light onto Ocean Road. Proceed on Ocean Road, make a sharp left turn at the stop sign, get in the right lane and turn right at the first traffic light after the stop sign (at the Recreation Center) and into the MESA/18 PARKING STRUCTURE. CHES registration will be held in the University Center Corwin Pavilion Wednesday – Friday. CHES sessions take place in Campbell Hall.

TRAVEL

- **By Air:** For your convenience, we recommend making flight reservations with Santa Barbara Municipal Airport (SBA) as your final destination. UCSB campus is a ten-minute drive from the airport.
- Santa Barbara Airbus (bus shuttle from LAX): This service provides several daily bus trips from Los Angeles International Airport to Santa Barbara (appx. \$88 round-trip if reserved in advance). Reservations are strongly recommended (see www.sbairbus.com).
- **By Train**: Santa Barbara is served by Amtrak Train Service. Amtrak terminals are located in Santa Barbara (12–15 miles from campus) and Goleta (5 miles from campus).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- UCSB Recreation Center: The "RecCen" is open 7 days per week (daily hours vary). The cost for a day pass is \$12 for adults (child's rate also available), and a photo ID is required. Equipment includes racquetball and squash courts, weight training rooms, gym and 3 swimming pools.
- Climate: Summer weather in Santa Barbara is usually quite pleasant; the days are warm (75°F) and the nights are cool (55°F) with occasional fog or overcast skies. We recommend a sweater or light coat for evenings. UCSB is a walking campus, so be sure to wear comfortable shoes.
- **Cancellations:** Cancellation policies for the CHES conference are set by the conference General Chair and can be found on the conference website or by emailing the General Chair. Note that separate On-Campus Housing cancellation fees of \$50 apply for those who reserve on-campus accommodation that is canceled.
- Currency (Foreign Currency Exchange): It is strongly recommended that participants from outside the U.S. exchange their currency into dollars at the airport of entry (nearest currency exchange is 15km from campus).
